Idaho Correctional Industries

Established in 1974, Idaho Correctional Industries (ICI) of Boise, Idaho, is a self-funded, offender-training program whose goal is not to have offenders work IN prison, but to learn job and life skills they will use when they are OUT of prison.

ICI is passionate about rehabilitating and training offenders.

Martin Thomas, General Manager at ICI, is passionate about job training and rehabilitating offenders with up-to-date software and manufacturing equipment, which includes CNC routers and digital presses. ICI receives zero state funding, which means a tight budget for seven manufacturing centers: furniture, metal fabrication, print services, labor services, gifts & souvenirs, refurbished panel systems, and work zones.

According to Thomas, "There were so many dashboards for all the race cars running around the track; we input each entry twice! We weren't efficient at all.
