Lean materials management starts with barcoding incoming parts and raw materials, as well as all types of inventory. Whether receiving incoming raw materials, counting inventory in the warehouse, or transferring parts on the shop floor, the person handling the material simply scans the barcoded label and GS Mobile records the transaction in real time. This eliminates the data entry errors that occur when tracking barcoded labels by hand, and produces real-time transactional labels to speed up the materials management process.

RAW MATERIAL TRACKING

With configured options, you can automatically receive parts into your inventory default bin or stocking bin. Simply scan the label, and the data instantly goes on the <u>Inventory Master</u>.

Bin-to-bin transfers are a snap. Scan the barcode label on the bin where you pull the part, scan again when the part goes into a different bin, and you're done. GS Mobile's highly reflective labels offer excellent visibility. Angled bin labels make it easy to scan overhead bins. And with some scanners, you can scan up to a distance of 50 feet.

GS Mobile also lets you issue material at the point of picking for a work order, enabling material handlers to process transactions and update inventory and WIP in real-time. You can scan the material sequence on the work order, which greatly reduces the number of clicks and screens required to issue material from raw material inventory to work in process. You can even label materials picked to WIP by printing a transactional issue-to-work order label.

MOBILE TOOL TRACKING

GS Mobile simplifies the tool tracking process through wireless receipt of purchase orders in the tool room and bin transfers to tool vending machines.
